Ever wondered what goes on at a draft test or preparing for an upcoming draft test or just want help with some draft skills? Join us on May 5 at Frontier Park Shelter 3 in Graham.

The Leonberger Club of the Northwest is hosting a LCA Draft Test judged by our very own Jennifer Brightbill and Ruth Nielsen. All are encouraged to enter the LCA draft test, details can be found here: <https://leonbergerclubnw.com/Leonberger-Events/LCA-Draft-Test.html>

BMDCGS is partnering with the Leonberger club to offer match runs and/or coaching sessions after the LCA Draft Test. And you can do both – test and match/coaching!

BMDCA Judges Nancy Van Horne, Karen Petersen, Ruth Nielsen, and Jennifer Brightbill (if weather and timing allow) will be available to coach teams and match runs. Since the match/coaching will follow the completion of the LCA draft test, there may be a limit on the number of match entries that can be accommodated. If match/coaching entries must be limited due to time constraints the entries will be accommodated based on date received.

Entered teams can choose between individual coaching sessions and/or a maneuvering course practice run-through of the Leonberger test course. LCA and BMDCA draft regs are very similar and the coaches can help you with any questions you have. Training, training treats, and toys are encouraged in the ring and in coaching sessions. It will provide great practice for those of you who are preparing for entering draft tests and can provide a lot of information for those of you learning/wanting to see what it's like and practice draft skills or get help with tough draft skills. The judges and volunteers can and will help you through the whole process as requested. Copies of the actual BMDCA judge's worksheets will be provided to you to keep as a souvenir. You get to choose what you do in the maneuvering ring, full course as laid out for a test or practice specific things, just let the judges know. To enter the match, your dog(s) should already be comfortable pulling a cart and may be of any age capable of safely pulling their cart.
